

SUPER BMX NEW ZEALAND series



BMXNZ, CNZ & the sport of BMX have developed a key race series around the Senior Development Program (SDP). Where the goal is to create a valid high performance race series that will bring an increased level of skill & ability together, so that the riders can progress their race craft & skill in a local environment.

The initial Series will be undertaken over 4 events to be held at the following locations

17 September 2016

New Plymouth BMX – St Andrews Dr, Bell Block

8 October 2016

Te Awamutu BMX – Park Rd, Te Awamutu

25 September 2016

Cambridge BMX – Milton St, Cambridge

23 October 2016

Cambridge BMX – Milton St, Cambridge

SERIES PARAMETERS: All events will be 3 moto, 3 final format using a mixture of Challenge and Pro Tracks. All qualifying Moto's will all be run on the Challenge track.
Male A Final will run on the Pro Track (decision on conditions made on day).
Female A Final will run on any Rhythm Pro straight that is available. (decision on conditions made on the day)
All other Finals to be run on the Challenge track.

CLASSES & LICENCE: UCI 15+ Male open licence & UCI 14+ Female open licence
Riders must hold a current BMX NZ race licence.
No riders riding up age groups accepted

ENTRIES & FEE: \$30 entry per event with \$25.00 payback. Entry as per each event flyer

REGISTRATION: As per individual event flyers & entry dates.

POINTS: 8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1

LANE DRAW: Random lane selection per seeding of riders into motos.

RACE FORMAT: BMXNZ Race format.

MIN CLASS SIZE: Will be determined at the close of entries.

SERIES TOTAL: Based on results from rounds will be published on www.cyclingnewzealand.nz

TIEBREAKER: At event or end of the series winner will be decided by countback.

PRIZE PURSE: There will be a rider proportional purse per event to be presented at each event. Purse to be spread across A & B finals. Plus an overall Purse spread over the top 8 in Male & Female. No trophies or presentation plates.

CSE: This series replaces the previous Championship Selection Events (CSE). The series events have been confirmed with CNZ that selectors can use the performance & results as PART of the championship selection process.
