MINIMUM CLASS SIZE

5 riders constitute a class (amalgamations as required).
Class sizes will be determined after the close of entries for trophy allocation purposes.

TIED POSITIONS:

All tied positions will be separated by Count back.

SUPERCLASS & CHAMPIONSHIP SELECTION EVENT:

Pro track is compulsory for Male riders in these events.
Block racing will be held with intervals of approximately 20/30 minutes.

Teams will be selected to travel to Australia to represent NZ in the
Mighty 11's Cultural Exchange and Australia vs. New Zealand - Mighty 11's Test.

The selection is open to **all riders** who will be 11 years old (actual age) on **1 June 2015**.

<u>Format Mighty 11's:</u>	All Riders	4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then;
	8 or less riders	Points added to 5 th (final) moto to determine top 4 placings.
	9 - 24 riders	Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points.
	25 + riders	Top 16 riders race semi finals, points added to '3 best moto' points Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

*Count back system to determine semi final and final positions. Semi finals placing, last 'counted' moto placing, if necessary.
Finish position in Final will determine team selection if points tied. Riders select lanes for Semifinals and Finals*

GATE: 8 Lane Gate.

POINTS: 1 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 5 – 6 – 7 – 8 BMX NZ Moto Mixing.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All riders must compete in the 2015 BMX New Zealand National Championships
2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and comply with the BMX NZ Test Teams Contract. (Copies available upon request from the BMX NZ Administrator admin@bmxnz.co.nz). Contracts to be signed on the day of selection.
3. Riders must attend arranged team training sessions as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management.
4. Riders must be available to travel to Australia – during May & June 2015. During this period riders will be billeted or accommodated only as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management. (Late returns with family are possible by arrangement).
5. All riders must have current passports and entry rights into Australia, copies of which must be handed in at time of selection (please have copies of passport with you at the BMX NZ National Championships selection to hand over with the signed contract.
6. Riders selected will be required to pay to BMX NZ - Australian dollars \$200.00 to assist with the costs.
