Male: 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17-24, 25-29, Junior, Elite, 30-39, 40-49, 50 plus

Female: 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17-24, 25-29, Junior, Elite, 30-39, 40 plus

Cruiser Classes: - minimum class size 5

Mixed: 8-10, 11-12.

Male: 13-14, 15-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50 & Over

Female: 13-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-39, 40 & Over

Superclass: - minimum class size 5

Mixed: 14 & Over

Number Plates:

Number plates will be issued to riders by the Club Team Manager and must be used within this event, including all official practice sessions.

A rider holding a 1 – 8 ranking from the following meetings; World Championships 2015, BMX NZ National Championships 2015, Oceania Championships 2015, North Island Titles 2015 or South Island Titles 2015 and wish to use this number at the meeting must ensure that the ranking is clearly

marked on the entry form. All riders not entering with these rankings will be issued with randomly selected numbers.

Championship riders may choose a number, but must respect the requirements of the UCI permanent number system.

Superclass:

3 qualifying rounds on Saturday, rounds 2, 3, 4.
Points over 3 finals on Sunday, rounds 5, 6 and final round.

Lane draws for the finals will be selected at the first final using the 'Lane draw selection' matrix.

Trophies Allocation:**Challenge Classes - with 8 riders or less:**

Trophies and Race Plates to 3rd place.

Challenge Classes - with 9 riders or more:

Trophies to 3rd place and Race Plates to 8th place.

Championship Classes:

Trophies and Race Plates to 3rd place.

Superclass:

Payout to 8th place using BMX NZ standard matrix

Class numbers:

Determined from the time that entries close for Trophy purposes.

Placings - Count back:

Riders on equal points at the end of racing will be separated using the count back method.

Finals Lane Draw – Age Group classes:

Quarters, Semis and Finals Only. Computer seeding order of lane choice.

UCI Age for all classes:

Riders will ride UCI age classes for this event. Standard racing formats apply for riders holding Kiwi Sprocket, Challenge or Championship licence types.

Superclass entries:

Riders must also enter an Age Group in either 20" or Cruiser.

Prizegiving:

This will be undertaken trackside approximately 30 minutes after the end of racing on Sunday.
