ADDRESS OF EVENT

The venue is based at Bexley Park, 498 Pages Road, Bexley, Christchurch. Please respect the requirements around event parking, there is NO PARKING on the access road to the track.

ALCOHOL & SMOKING

All BMXNZ Major Events are Smoke, Drug and Alcohol Free. Please adhere to this ruling, it is for the benefit of the riders & children at the 2020 Nationals venue. Smoking is only permitted on the access road side only & away from the facility boundaries.

ANIMALS

The event is a BMXNZ major meeting where the focus is on the riders & their preparation. No animals are allowed anywhere on the event site and there are no exceptions other than registered Working or Guide Dogs.

BANNERS

Club or product banners are to be attached to club tents only, do not hang them over any existing signage around the track. Offending Banners will be removed. If you wish to promote other products or services, please contact the club to arrange an approved display location.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The event is the Nationals and it is understandably a pressure environment. Please be aware of your riders, your supporters & your own demeaner & attitude this weekend. We are here for the riders, most of which are kids. The Sports Code of Conduct applies at all times, in all areas, to all people present, not just the riders.

PARKING

Car parking for the event will be in the grassed reserve alongside the track off the access Road. The Club parking coordinators will allocate parking on the day. The Officials parking is for those with an issued official pass.

PIT GAZEBOs

Trackside areas for Gazebos is allocated per region. Personal gazebos can be placed on advice of the event officials, please listen to advice given.

Gazebos can be set up from 10am Friday, gazebos are the responsibility of the owner, please be aware of the possible weather forecasts.

PRIZE GIVING

Due to the COVID delay in this event & the further holdup in Alert Level changes, Prize Giving will be with Presentation Plates & Perpetual Trophies only, Event Trophies will be sent to clubs following the event. Sprockets will receive a event certificate upon completion of their last moto.

PROTESTS

Any riding issue will be required to be managed by the Club Manager. Issues/Protests can be accepted by the Appeal Commissaire Doug McElhinney withing 15min of a race result being posted. The Finishline camera is the final call on all finishing positions.

RACING START TIMES

Both days 11am race start – ensure all riders head to staging at least 10 minutes prior to start of the first race to ensure racing starts on time.

RACE FORMAT

Please see the Official flyer for race format – the following detail is the pending class format as it currently stands (before medicals are removed leading to class number changes):

Classes racing **7** motos **POINTS OVER** All Sprockets Classes, 8G/9G/11G/12G/14-15G/16G/35-39M/40-44M/50+M/25+F/11-12CRM/15-16CRM/17-34CRM/35-39CRM/40-44CRM/13-24CRF/25+CRF

Classes racing 6 motos followed by **SEMIs** & then deadman finals -8M/9M/10M/10G/11M/12M/13M/14M

ALL other classes not listed above will race 6 motos to a deadman final. Please note the format can change once registration is complete & all medicals are taken into effect.

Please note that the BMXNZ random computer moto mixing & lane draws is used for all challenge classes.

The moto draw is on our.sqorz.com when click on the moto.

REFUNDS

NO refunds will be authorised after Saturday 24 October at the close of rego at 8.30am. Any refunds prior to this time will be given on receipt of a medical certificate less an administration fee of \$20. Please email medical certificates to admin@bmxnz.co.nz or give to your Team Manager to hand in at the admin hut during registration.

RACE PLATE ALLOCATION

Collection of rider's plates is to be done by **TEAM MANAGERS ONLY**. They will be issued with a returns sheet to write down any riders that are not racing. They will return this sheet to admin by 8.30am on Saturday. If the sheet is not returned it is presumed that all of your club riders are racing & they will be in the Moto Draws which once issued can not be changed.

Team Managers can collect plates at the track point huts strictly between 9.30am and 10.30am on Friday or between 7.30am and 8:30am on Friday. Do not ask outside of these times. Plates will not be issued to individual riders.

Riders Packs will issued to club managers.

RUBBISH

It is everyone's responsibility to ensure that you keep your pit or club area tidy & place all rubbish in the bins provided.

SECURITY

Security will be patrolling the area from 5pm-7am each night/morning from Friday 23 until the conclusion of BMXNZ Nationals. Gazebos or any property left on site are at your own risk.

TRANSPONDERS / EVENT REGISTRATION

This is a Transponder required event. Transponders must be activated & registered with MYLAPS prior to this events. Transponders MUST be attached to the outside of the fork & must be on for all official BMXNZ event sessions including practice.

ALL transponders must be checked and entry detail confirmed on the BMXNZ test loop prior to racing. This check is REQUIRED for event registration. The loop will be on site at the admin area for registration for the Friday and Saturday practice sessions ONLY. Bikes without transponders or transponder failure will be allocated a DNS at the event.

EVENT VILLAGE & VENDORS

These are located in the open space behind the final straight gazebo area. Please note this is not a rider pit area
